# **Updates on Initiatives**

## **Bertha Park Christmas Market**

Plans are ongoing regarding hosting a Bertha Park Christmas Market on 30<sup>th</sup> November in The Hub and Starfish Cakes and Bakes. There will be a diverse range of stalls and a visit from Santa.

An application has been made to the Developers Fund to see if we can fund a small gift to children from Santa. This application is supported by our elected Councillors and the Luncarty CC. Support has also been received from local businesses and Springfield have offered a donation towards this event.

#### **Geddes Avenue Data**

PKC recently installed 'traffic tubes' to monitor traffic using Geddes Avenue and to capture speeds of vehicles.

Traffic tubes were installed on Geddes Avenue between Mercer Street and Duff Street. Data captured during August showed that the average speed of vehicles was 24.7. Data from Caesar Avenue showed an average speed of 16.7 mph.

Based on this data, PKC have indicated that no further traffic calming measures are required.
